Night Before Surgery Instructions:

- If the animal normally stays outdoors overnight, he/she must stay indoors the evening before surgery.
- Animal MUST HAVE ALL FOOD WITHDRAWN BY 9:00PM the night before surgery. This
 ensures that the animal's stomach is empty by the time he's put under general anesthesia.
 This lessens the chances that the animal will vomit and aspirate the vomit into his lungs. If your
 adult pet has eaten on the morning of surgery, the veterinary clinic will refuse surgery.

Post Surgery Instructions:

- Please make sure you arrive on-time to pick up your animal friend.
- Please follow post-surgery care instructions provided to you by the Veterinary Clinic providing your pets spay or neuter.
- Animals should be kept inside in a dry, clean, climate controlled, supervised environment for a minimum of 72 hours.
- Additional services you may wish to consider on the day of the appointment to be paid directly
 to the veterinarian you choose: microchipping, heartworm testing & preventative, deworming,
 pain medicine and a cone to discourage licking incision site, etc. These services and their
 ADDITIONAL COST can all be discussed with the veterinary office when making the
 appointment or at time of drop off.
